Last year was one of extraordinary growth for Nine Lives Foundation. Our spay/neuter program grew by 54% compared to 2023, helping reduce unwanted litters and promote healthier cat communities. We also grew our Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program by 100% for the second consecutive year, leading the area in this critical service. We're proud to collaborate with over 50 rescues, offering best-practice, low-cost medical services and saving lives together. Adoptions rose by 38%, and as a certified No-Kill Shelter we were able to increase intake by 37%, allowing us to save even more cats in need!

So far in 2025 we are set to surpass the extraordinary growth seen in previous years, and our reach is expanding by the day.



Valentina arrived at Nine Lives suffering from severe skin disease, ear infections, and parasites. She was in so much pain she would scratch her face raw. For months, our veterinary team provided best-in-class care — special diets, medications, enrichment, and constant monitoring — to manage her chronic allergies and flare-ups. Her journey included repeated treatments, rechecks, and lots of patience from staff and volunteers who never gave up on her. After more than three months of dedicated care, she was finally healthy enough to graduate from medical hold. Today, Valentina is thriving in her forever home — proof that Nine Lives is always here for kitties in need, offering them very best chance for a brighter future.


LOW COST SPAY & NEUTER

2024 SPAY/NEUTER IMPACT

In 2024, Nine Lives performed 6,327 spay/neuter surgeries — a 54% increase from 2023 (4,109). This incredible growth reflects our commitment to addressing cat overpopulation on every front and we are set to surpass these totals already in 2025! Of the 6,327 surgeries we performed in 2024, 2,678 were for feral and community cats through our Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program. Nine Lives is proud to be the premier TNR clinic in the Bay Area!

A LIFELINE FOR CATS ACROSS OUR COMMUNITY

- Over 50 rescue partners depend on us to spay/neuter their cats, provide wellness exams, and perform lifesaving interventions that prepare animals for adoption.
- Pet owners across the Bay Area rely on our affordable, low-cost services to keep their cats healthy and prevent unplanned litters.
- Our Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program
 humanely manages community cats and
 colonies, giving outdoor cats safer lives while
 reducing the cycle of overpopulation.

KITTEN SEASON LEADERS



In 2024, Nine Lives **rescued 595 kittens**, compared to 297 in 2023 — **a 100% increase in just one year**. Kitten Season continues to be a crisis in our community, overwhelming shelters and leaving the most vulnerable at risk. **From fragile neonatal bottle babies to kittens battling chronic illness**, Nine Lives provides best-practice, around-the-clock care to give them a chance at life. Year after year, we are expanding our reach to meet the growing demand, ensuring that **more at-risk kittens survive**, **thrive**, **and find their forever homes**. Already in 2025, **we've shattered last year's kitten rescue totals** — and the demand for our lifesaving work continues to climb higher every day.

The Future of Cat Rescue Is Here: Welcome to the New Nine Lives!

In a monumental milestone in our history, Nine Lives' shelter and clinic will unite under one purpose-built roof designed for high-volume feline care. This transformational space will double our capacity to rescue, heal, and rehome cats, with dedicated medical suites, expanded adoption areas, and a state-of-the-art shelter medicine hub — allowing us to provide more advanced, affordable care faster and with greater compassion than ever before!

By 2028, this new facility will allow us to:

- Perform 10,000+ surgeries every year, including spay/neuter, dental, and lifesaving interventions
- Rescue and rehome over 2,000 cats annually, including the most vulnerable and medically fragile
- Deliver lifesaving dental surgeries at our best-in-class surgical center
- Prevent suffering and surrenders with accessible wellness programs for pets and families
- Serve as a lifeline for community and feral cats, and a vital regional resource for rescue groups
- Engage and educate through public workshops, adoption fairs, and volunteer training programs

This is more than a building — it's a promise: Every cat, no matter their past, will have a future.

From complex **dentals to delicate amputations**, we are performing specialty surgeries not only for our own cats, but for the animals of fellow rescues who need our help. Together, we are determined to save more lives than ever before.

Expanding Access to Care

In 2024, Nine Lives grew our low-cost vaccine clinic — offering 100% more appointments than in 2023. With bilingual staff coverage seven days a week, we ensure that every member of our community can access the care their cats need. Uniquely, Nine Lives also provides wellness appointments for feral cats, safely sedating them to deliver essential treatments often unavailable elsewhere. By breaking barriers to care, we are keeping more cats healthy, safe, and in loving homes.



LITTLE SURFER'S STORY



At just four weeks old and weighing less than a pound, Lil' Surfer faced euthanasia after being abandoned at a local shelter with a painful, infected wound that left him unable to urinate. After he was brought to Nine Lives in critical condition, our medical team performed emergency surgery and gave him the intensive care he needed to survive. Today, Lil' Surfer is thriving — a playful, affectionate kitten who embodies our mission: providing lifesaving interventions and rescuing the most vulnerable cats and kittens from the brink of euthanasia. Little Surfer represents just one of almost 600 kittens saved in 2024.

VOLUNTEERS - OUR PARTNERS IN LIFESAVING

Celebrating Our Volunteers

In 2024, **150 active volunteers** dedicated over **11,000 hours** to caring for cats and supporting our lifesaving programs — a **25% increase in the number of volunteers** and **22% more hours** compared to 2023. This remarkable growth was fueled by the introduction of new roles, such as **Hospital Helpers**, who provide vital post-operative recovery support. By expanding opportunities to serve, our volunteers not only skyrocketed their total hours but also enabled us to **help more cats and kittens than ever before.**

We are deeply grateful for their compassion, commitment, and countless hours of effort. Their generosity of time and spirit makes our lifesaving work possible.



Without our incredible foster families, we could not rescue as many vulnerable, underage, or shy cats and kittens. In 2024, foster homes gave countless cats the chance to grow, heal, and thrive outside the shelter — a lifesaving gift that shortens shelter stays and prepares them for adoption.

- 107 foster homes opened their doors
- 424 cats and kittens spent time in foster
- 10,000 cat-days of love and care were provided



Life in a shelter can be stressful for cats, but our Fear Free® Cat Care and Enrichment program eases anxiety and nurtures their emotional well-being. With personalized playtime, gentle touch, and plenty of treats, our cats gain confidence — helping them feel at home faster and shortening their length of stay on the path to adoption.





In 2024, for the first time in our history, we surpassed \$1 million in donations, fueled largely by grassroots giving. An incredible 2,787 donors stood with us last year — a 27% increase from 2023's 2,200 donors — showing just how deeply our mission resonates with

the community.
